For artists — what you need to know:

- Artworks must be 12x12 inches or smaller.
- Any medium.
- No jurying for entry.
- Two pieces maximum.
- Entry fee of \$30 for one or two pieces. No entry fee for kids.
- Drop off Thursday, 1/8/2026 through Sunday, 1/11/2026 from 11:00am 4:00pm.
- Exhibit runs from Thursday, 1/15/2026 through Saturday, 2/28/2026 from 11:00am 4:00pm.
- Art pick up dates are Saturday, 2/28/2026 through Sunday, 3/1/2026 from 11:00am 4:00pm.

Reception: Saturday, January 17, 3pm to 6pm.
