Join us for some holiday food and refreshments on 11/19/2022 from 12pm-6pm and 11/20/2022 from 12pm-4pm.





Becki Hesedahl - Focus Artist

Becki typically develops her art with watercolor. She has mastered her artistry using birds, flowers and landscapes as her muses. She has also taught art classes throughout the region.

In addition to watercolor papers, Becki loves working with Yupo, a polypropylene material that is very different than working on paper. YUPO is an acid free, archival, synthetic surface that is recyclable, waterproof and tree-free. It is a compelling and unique alternative to traditional art papers. The paint dries on the surface of the format unlike watercolor paper where the paint sinks into the paper.

Barb and Becki's shows will be up through December 2022.
