September show "Interbeing: Weave of Influence"

We are excited to bring you an outstanding group of abstract Oregon artists in September! They have worked together since 2020 and have developed a close, creative relationship that shows in their work. This exhibit is comprised of a traveling art exhibit involving five artists. The group of abstract artists was created in August 2020 amongst uncertainty and isolation in the early phase of Covid-19. Oregon artists Jan Lintz, Susan Thomas, Donna Henderson, Teresa Myrmo and Mary Garrard

attended the first online weekly "Open Studio" offered by Eugene abstract artist Zoë Cohen. The group immediately formed a strong connection, becoming an important source of support for each other as they weathered not only the fears, grief and isolation of the pandemic, but also the catastrophic wildfire season of 2020.

"We each have found freedom and new directions in our art practice. While our individual artistic aesthetics are distinct and specific, we influence each other's work in sometimes subtle, sometimes surprising ways, for example, by related color palettes or compositional elements. This is an organic process that may happen indirectly without conscious intention. An intentional way we do this is by trading "starts" (work in early
